Your Roadmap to Medicare

Navigating your Medicare enrollment timeline can be confusing. Use this handy guide for a smooth transition.

Medicare Part A

May be enrolled Since Medicare Part A is

3 months before retirement Since Medicare Part A is available at no cost to individuals who have worked a minimum of 40 quarters (or their spouse has), you may or may not be enrolled at age 65. You may have received a Medicare Card in the mail with your Part A effective date. If not, you can simply enroll at the same time you enroll in Medicare Part B. For individuals who qualify for premium free Part A, there is no penalty for enrolling after age 65.

Enroll in a Medicare Supplement

Please call us to review your options for Medicare Supplements and Rx plans. HTA can compare options for Medicare Supplements, Medicare Advantage and Medicare Part D Rx Plans with over 30 carriers. Please call us to review your options and complete enrollment. We are happy to guide you through this process and shop the coverages for you.

Medicare Part B

Recommended: ENROLL

1 month before retirement It is imperative that you ENROLL in Part B (and A). You have 8 months after you are no longer "actively at work" to enroll with no penalty. However, once you are no longer "actively at work" Medicare is the primary insurer, so you may have gaps in your coverage if you wait the full 8 months. HTA can provide an employer verification form that you can have your HR team complete. This should show you had creditable coverage and avoid a penalty. You should request your Part B effective date to coincide with the cancellation of your group health plan.
